What is Unity for Life?

Unity for Life began as a benefit dinner for Lifehouse Maternity Home a few years after Lifehouse opened its doors in 2008. Speakers, dinner, testimony, and even theater, all to help raise financial support for Lifehouse.

After a year hiatus, plans for a 2020 Unity for Life breakfast were being made when the pandemic struck, putting our plans on hold for two years. Now, for 2022, Lifehouse is pivoting to a virtual Unity for Life event, bringing back the testimonies and stories of success in a safe, online format. We hope you will join us!

On Wednesday, May 18 and Thursday, May 19, Lifehouse will share a mix of stories, donor recognition, volunteer highlights and much more. We are asking our supporters (that's you!) to share those stories and add their own. We are also offering the opportunity for supporters and their friends to set personal fundraising goals and make donations to support the lives at Lifehouse.

How to Have the Greatest Impact

Our Goal **\$50,000**

Pray about what you can do to help us achieve our goal of raising **\$50,000** during Unity for Life. You can have the most impact by engaging in "peer-to-peer fundraising." To set up a peer-to-peer fundraiser, access our online platform to create your fundraising page, tell the people in your networks about how you are personally connected to Lifehouse, and share your fundraising page with them. Remember that you are not asking your friends for money: You are giving them the opportunity to live out their faith by being the hands and feet of Christ. "A generous person will prosper; whoever refreshes others will be refreshed."

We're using an online platform called GiveGab to make donating and setting up fundraising

pages as simple as possible. If you have ever participated in Give for Good Louisville through the Community Foundation of Louisville, our GiveGab page for Unity for Life will look very familiar! You can access our Unity for Life campaign page at givegab.com/campaigns/unityforlife

By supporting Lifehouse, you are offering moms and babies abundant life now, and introducing them to Jesus Christ, who will give them eternal life in the future.

1. Set up your fundraising page, or contact us for help in creating one. Visit givegab.com/campaigns/unityforlife to create your personal fundraising page that you can share with your friends, family, and others in your circle. If you've never created a GiveGab profile before, you will be prompted to register.* After logging in, you will see options to customize your page by setting your personal fundraising goal, adding a personalized message, and setting up a thank-you message that your donors will receive.

If you need help creating a fundraising page or if you need one created for you, we can email you a link or create one for you. If you want mailable hard copy donation envelopes for donors interested in giving offline, please call us at 502-897-1655.

2. Compile a list of friends, family, and others in your circle you'll invite to participate. Unlike events where you sponsor a table, the Unity for Life virtual event is like inviting your friends and family to dinner, without the cost of buying them dinner. Once your fundraising page is created, you'll be ready to send your site's link to your network. See the back of this toolkit to help you create your list and decide how you will contact each person.

4. Share Lifehouse Unity for Life content on social media and email. We will be posting on our Facebook (Lifehouse Maternity Home), Twitter (@LifehouseLvl), and Instagram (@lifehouselouisville) pages, and we will send out emails as well. Share with and forward the content to your networks!

You'll always have the option to make your donation anonymously, even on your personal fundraiser page. If you'd like to donate from your donor advised fund or add a major gift to be used anonymously for a matching challenge, please call us at 502-897-1655.

Why Support Lifehouse Maternity Home?

The mission of Lifehouse is to provide wrap-around support for pregnant and parenting women and teens for up to four years; addressing physical, emotional, spiritual and intellectual needs to provide healing and hope. We not only provide a safe home, food, and clothing; we also introduce our residents to Jesus Christ.

Overcoming Barriers

So much has changed in our world and with the women Lifehouse serves. Our residents come with histories of abuse, neglect, domestic violence, trafficking, addiction, incarceration, foster care, self-harm, and other trauma. These circumstances alone are overwhelming. Add an unexpected pregnancy to the mix, and the situation becomes a crisis.

The pandemic has led to limited housing options, mental health breakdowns, loss of employment and childcare, lack of transportation options, restricted access to healthcare, and nearly impossible to reach social services. Throughout this time, Lifehouse has been a safety net for residents – providing a safe, healthy home; food; clothing; emergency childcare; transportation to services; case management to navigate social programs; connection to therapists; job readiness assistance; and so much more.

Changing & Saving Lives

In 2020, we formalized our program into "Lifepath," a three-part program designed to walk residents through pregnancy, childbirth, infancy, toddlerhood, life-skills and relationships while transitioning to greater independence and self-support. Each step is based in Biblical truth and Christ's love. In 2021, we began reaching out to our alumnae, ensuring that they know Lifehouse is for LIFE, and a resource for them, no matter where they are in their journey.

Lifehouse transforms lives, helping residents overcome trauma, build life skills, and work their way towards sustainable stability. Lifehouse is staffed 24/7/365 days of the year. Our five full-time programming staff and over a dozen House Moms work every day to help our residents grow, develop, and become the best moms they can be.

We want you to partner with us in changing and saving lives!
